In conjunction with the Consultative Committee of Accountancy Bodies (CCAB-I), I would like to invite you and your members to an information session on steps that small businesses should take to prepare for Brexit.

As you may be aware, the EU and the UK have [agreed](#) an extension to 31 October 2019 so that the political process in the UK can continue, with the aim of ensuring an orderly withdrawal of the UK from the EU.

I am firmly of the view that businesses should use this period to get Brexit ready.

Two information sessions are being held in Cavan and Monaghan for local accountants and their small business clients.

The event in **Cavan** will take place in the Cavan Crystal Hotel on Thursday 4th July 2019, between 8:00am and 10:30am. The event in **Monaghan** will take place in the Four Seasons Hotel Monaghan on Monday 8 July, between 8:00am and 10:30am.

Topics that will be covered include:

- The range of Government supports for businesses, including cashflow management
- Import and export controls, including customs
- Supply chain management including accreditation and product certification
