When we receive your form, we will issue an email which you can bring to the V and W (Dundalk) Recycling Centre, Newry Road, Dundalk to collect your Clean Up pack.

You can then plan your clean up in your local area over the weekend beginning 22nd July. When you have finished your clean up please send an email to the above email address and your waste will be collected. Include in the email your name, contact number and the exact location of the bags to be picked up.

Most importantly the scheme is an opportunity for you or your community to work together on a project which benefits everybody.

- Removing litter
- Report illegal dumping
- Cleaning and maintaining signs
